On 30 July 1946, Aleksandar Beliĉ, the then president of the Serbian Academy of Sciences (SAS), announced the launch of the sole institute of the Academy – the Mathematical Institute. Thus, the Mathematical Institute is usually regarded as the first scientific institute of SAS.
