Transfer from the airport

At the airport, each participant will be welcomed by organizers, and then accompanied to a special bus to the hotel. The cost of this transfer will be covered by the local organizers.

Currency and payments

The only currency in the official use in Serbia is Serbian dinar. The ratio fluctuates, but it is approximately 1 euro = 105 dinars.

The hotel reception accepts cash payments in Serbian dinars as well as Visa and Diners cards. There is a banking machine in the hotel, accepting Visa, Diners, and Master cards.
