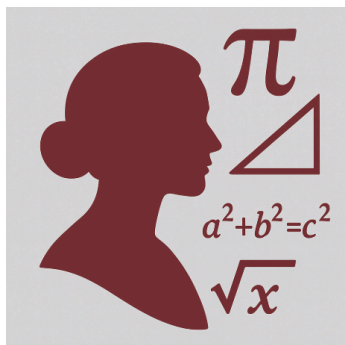


Celebrating Women in Mathematics 2025
