In July 1914, during the Austro-Hungarian attack on Belgrade, the Captain Miša's Mansion, in which the Mathematical Seminar of Belgrade University had its library and cabinet, was bombarded.

The work of the Seminar and its associates - Bogdan Gavrilović, Mihailo Petrović, Milutin Milanković, Mladen Berić and Sima Marković - was temporarily suspended during World War I. Milanković in his memoirs testifies that

the two rooms and the library of the Mathematical Seminar did not suffer any damage at that time.
