1. INTRODUCTION

Papers should be written in Serbian or English. Original should be perpared in Word for Windows, on one sided A4 (210x297mm) paper. Margines: 2,5cm-top, 2cm down, left and right. Please, leave the space of the size 3,5cm for the Symposium logo on the first page. See the example on the top of this page.

Papers should not contain more than 4 pages, including pictures, tables, references and appendices.

Body text should be in two columns separated by 0,5cm margine. Within paragraphs spacing is single and between paragraphs, please use double space.

Last page should contain columns of the same length, as it is shown on the second page of this example.

2. TITLES AND SUBTITLES

Title of the paper (preferably in both languages: Serbian and English) should be places through the both columns, as well as the names and addresses of the authors.

Please use **1250 encoding**, font **Times New Roman** in the following sizes:

- title 14 pt bold,
- names of the authors and their addresses 10 pt,
- titles of the sections 11 pt bold,

- body text 10 pt.

Do not indent the beginning of the paragraph.

3. ABSTRACT AND KEY WORDS

After the title of the paper and names of the authors and their addresses, an abstract and key words (in both languages) should follow in font 10 pt italic, through the both columns (just like in this example).

4. EQUATIONS

Equations should be (preferably) in the single column with the numbers flushed to the right, e.g.:

$$\frac{2e^x}{x} = a \tag{1}$$

5. GRAPHIC PARTS

Pictures (figures), tables i and other graphic parts of the paper, please, strech to the one column size, if possible. One may use the width of whole page for both equations and graphic parts if necessary, but then the text to follow should return to the two column style.

The numeration of these graphic parts should be sa in the Following examples.




Figure 1. Figure title
