Marija Šegan-Radonjić is a Historian and Research Associate at the Mathematical Institute SANU (MISANU). She received her Ph.D. in History and Philosophy of Natural Sciences and Technology from the University of Belgrade in 2019. Her research interests include Digitization of Cultural Heritage, History of Education, Science and Culture, and Responsible Research and Innovation (RRI). In 2021, she was appointed as Secretary of the Archive of MISANU, responsible for collecting, describing, cataloging, and preserving the institute's archival material in the digital environment. Since 2022, she has been the WG Member in EU COST Action dedicated to the historical knowledge about creative computing in Europe: CA21141 - Grassroots of Digital Europe: from Historic to Contemporary Cultures of Creative Computing (GRADE), and since 2020 she is involved in the EU H2020 Project dedicated to the implementation of Gender Equality Plans and gender-responsive budgeting in the research performing organizations: LeTSGEPs - Leading Towards Sustainable Gender Equality Plans in research performing organizations (ID: 873072). Furthermore, since 2011, she has been engaged in cultural heritage digitization projects of MISANU, such as the development of the e-catalog "Cultural Monuments in Serbia," as well as activities dedicated to the science popularization, among others, the organization of the manifestation "May Month of Mathematics." She is a member of the MISANU RRI Council.
